OBJECTIVE

Provide an opportunity for youth and adults to participate together in a fun atmosphere to raise funds for the Pine Island Youth Bowling program.

FORMAT/RULES

1. Each team member will bowl 4 games. (The lowest score for each bowler will be discarded.)
2. Knocking down 9 or 10 pins on the first ball will be scored as a strike.
3. Tournament coordinator will attempt to limit the number of bowlers to 4 per lane when possible. For the last shift each day the limit can be expanded up to 6 bowlers per lane.

ELIGIBILITY

Youth: Entry will be open to all boys and girls that are current USBC youth members. Youth can bowl with any adult and adults are allowed to bowl with more than one youth.

Adults: Anyone greater than or equal to 18 yrs of age who is not currently bowling in a sanctioned youth bowling league.

ENTRIES: Pre-registration is requested/suggested. Walk-ups allowed as space permits.

DIVISIONS: All Divisions are determined by averages (combined average of both bowlers).

There are not separate divisions based on age or gender of the youth or adult.

Division I: Combined average of less than or equal to 320

Division II: Combined average of greater than 320

COST: \$40 per team (Make checks payable to Trailhead Lanes.)

HANDICAP: This is a handicap tournament. 90% of the difference between the combined averages and 440 will be awarded to each team. There will be no limit to the amount of handicap a team can have. $([440 - \text{combined averages}] \times 90\% \times 3 \text{ games} = \text{Total handicap per team})$ (Teams with more than 440 combined average will receive zero handicap.)

AVERAGES:

Youth Average: All averages will be based on highest 2017-2018 (current) average (min 8 games). If no current average then highest 2016-2017 average (min 8 games) will be used.

Adult Average: If a bowler does not have a 2017-2018 average of 8 games or more, that bowler will use their highest average at the end of the 2016-2017 or 2015-2016 season (min 21 games). All adult bowlers without an average stated under the previous conditions will be assigned an average of 220 and the team will be entered in the appropriate division based on the combined average of the adult and youth.

PRIZES: Minimum of \$200 + trophies guaranteed for 1st place in each division (based on 50 entries/division).

High actual series for the youth bowler in each division will also receive \$50. All monetary awards will be awarded solely to the youth bowler of each team as a scholarship through the SMART program. Payback will be based on 1 in 5 entries receiving a scholarship. A team of the same two bowlers can only place in the top 5 of a division 1 time. (Ex: If a team of the same two bowlers places in the top 5 twice, the lower of the two scores will receive the 6th place scholarship.)

OTHER: Any unsportsmanlike conduct may result in disqualification from participation with no refund at the discretion of the tournament official.
